

AVIAtest Sample test

Part 1 – Introductory interview (Duration: approx. 5 minutes)

A short interview focused on you and your experience in aviation.

Example:

- When did you start your career in air traffic control?
- Which units do you have experience with?

Part 2 – Listening comprehension (Duration: approx. 5 minutes)

The candidate will listen to six recordings –Prior to each recording, two questions for each of the recordings will be asked. The candidate is allowed to take notes. Each recording will be played once. After each recording, the candidate will answer the respective questions.

Two audio samples are available to download from our website www.aviatest.eu.

Audio sample 1: What is the callsign of the flight?

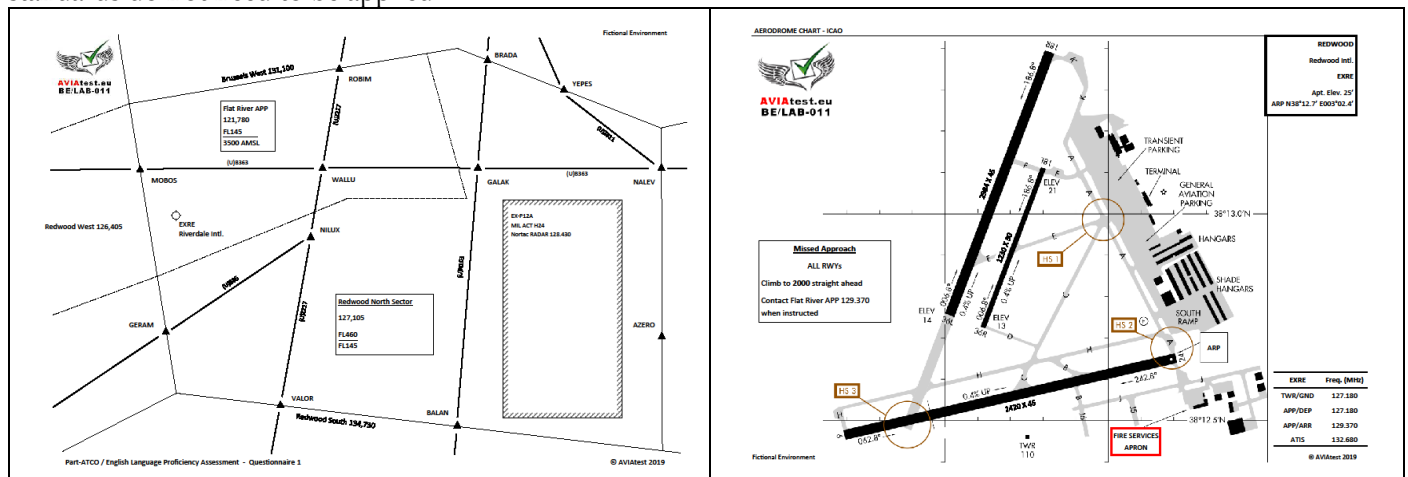
Audio sample 1: Which level is assigned by the controller?

Audio sample 2: What is the callsign of the flight?

Audio sample 2: Which speed is assigned by the controller?

Part 3 – A simulated traffic situation (Duration: approx. 5 minutes)

Each candidate is given an aerodrome or an area chart according to his choice of assessment – either for an approach or an ACC sector. The interlocutor simulates traffic conditions and the candidate is asked to perform ATC duties using correct phraseology. Of course, we are not asking any tactical ATC work as it is not the point, and separation standards do not need to be applied.



Part 4 – A follow-up discussion on aviation-related topics (Duration: approx. 10 minutes)

The candidate will be asked follow-up questions based on unusual situations encountered in the previous parts of the exam on various aviation-related topics (communication, weather, navigation, emergency situations, wildlife, medical emergency...). No technical knowledge is required.

Example:

- What do you think are some of the causes of miscommunication between controllers and pilots?
- How would you react to a medical emergency on board an aircraft under your control?
